The Chesterfield Township shoreline may experience high water levels due to forecasted weather conditions on **Sunday April 12, 2020 – Monday April 13, 2020**.

I urge all Chesterfield Township residents to remove trash and debris from your property with special emphasis on drain easements and ditches. Removal of debris will greatly reduce the environmental impacts to the basin, improve natural drainage, and decrease the potential of pump station failure.
